Thank you for visiting Basepoint Business Centre Crawley.

We have put together the following guide with information on travel and parking at the centre.

PARKING

The centre has very limited parking available.

Parking bays are reserved for permits holders only, evenly distributed amongst the businesses based at the centre.

For **short term visits of up to 2 hours maximum** there are visitor bays numbered 1-6, please obtain a permit from reception.

Please do not park in front of the bin stalls or kerbs as this prevents our waste collections.

FREE Off - site parking

Free road parking is available on Metcalf and County Oak Way.

As you approach via Metcalf Way with the centre on the left had side this road continues to loop round onto County Oak Way and there is free parking available just a short walk away from the centre.

County Oak Retail Park offers up to 2 hours of free parking.

Please note this is based on an automatic number plate recognition system, and is a very strict 2 hour limit with penalty fines issued.

Parking in Langley Green

Less than 5 minutes' walk from the centre is Langley Green Cherry Lane playing fields car park. (Point B on the map below) There is also free road parking available on this road and throughout this part of Langley Green.


To access this car park by car from the A23 turn down Martyrs avenue towards Langley Green, then turn right down Cherry Lane and the car park is situated at the end of the road.

To walk to Basepoint go along the public footpath towards Crawley play services and Cherry Lane adventure playground. The footpath continues past Basepoint business centre on your right hand side until it reaches Metcalf Way, turn right and the centre entrance is on the right hand side.

Please refer to the map as guidance below. Access is only by foot by directions below from point B to point A.
